#### Vocational Qualifications

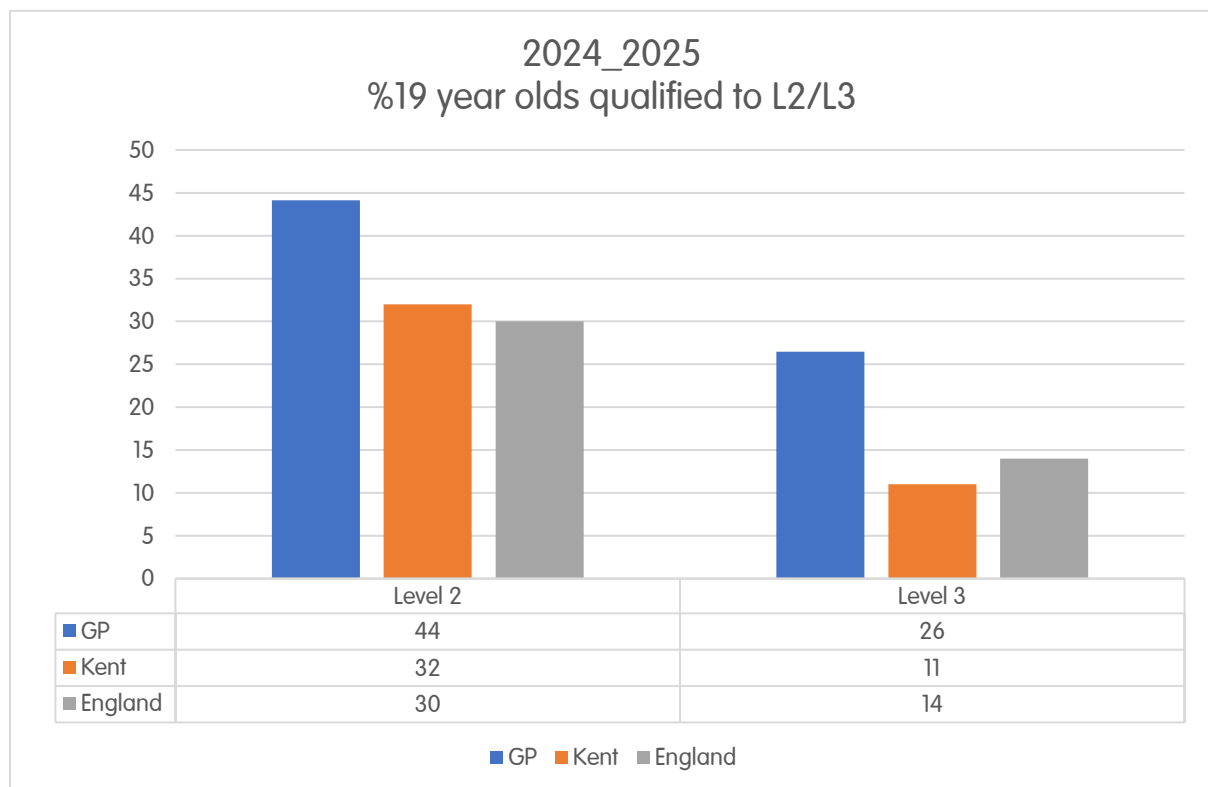
The vocational qualification is the largest part of the student's study programme.

- Three students did not achieve their full vocational qualification. 1 of 3 achieved unit certification. Three students were identified in previous data drops.
- Overall achievement was 91.2% and this is +7.4% above national rates (NR taken from Gov.uk)
- There was no significant variance across sites or the vocational course the students were undertaking.
- 2023/2024 overall achievement was 91.6%

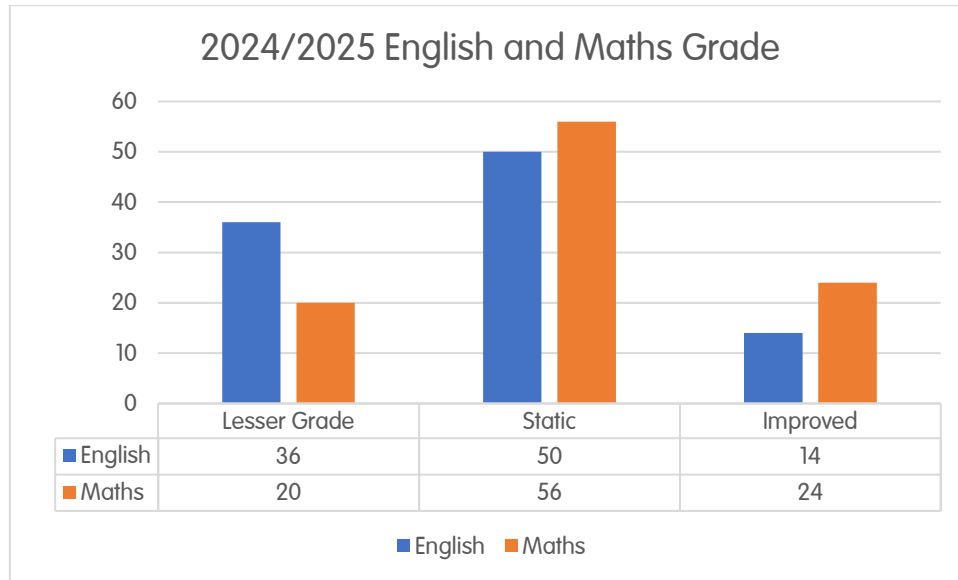

### Vocational Qualifications

- 100% of pupils on full-time timetables achieved a qualification in Personal and Social Development
- All pupils achieved certificates in
  - Independent Living (at least three per pupil)
  - PSHE
  - ICT
- 100% of pupils on full-time timetables completed work placement of their choice in two different workplaces

### Core Curriculum

- 100% pupils on fulltime timetables achieved an English and mathematics qualification
- 87.5% of pupils that sat English and
- 100% of pupils that sat English and maths GCSE achieved a grade
- 87.5% of pupils that sat both GCSE maths papers achieved at least a grade 2
  - One pupil achieved a grade 6
- 87.5% of pupils that sat English GCSE achieved at least a grade 2
  - Two pupils achieved a grade 4
